How to Test Flow on the Gaggia Velasca and Velasca Prestige

- 1. Unplug your machine from the power outlet
- 2. Press and hold 'Espresso' and 'Menu' (Velasca) or 'Espresso' and 'Special Drinks' (Velasca Prestige) and then plug the machine back in.
- 3. Once the software version appears on the machine display, you may release the buttons
- 4. Press 'Steam/Cappuccino' 4 times
- 5. "EV | PUMP" will appear at the top of the display
- 6. Press 'Espresso'. The display will now read "EV1 = ON"
- 7. Place a cup beneath your Pannarello wand/hot water spout
- 8. Press and hold 'Hot Water/Milk Froth'
- 9. Water should begin dispensing from the Pannarello wand (Velasca) or hot water spout (Velasca Prestige)
- 10. Take note of the number next to "L/H'
- 11. Stop holding 'Hot Water/Milk Froth, and press 'Espresso' to turn "EV1 = OFF"
- 12. Press 'Steam/Cappuccino' 5 times
- 13. "BU" Will appear at the top of the display
- 14. Press and hold 'Espresso' until the display reads "WORK = Y"
- 15. Press 'Steam/Cappuccino'
- 16. Place a cup under your coffee dispensing spout
- 17. Press and hold 'Hot Water/Milk Froth'
- 18. Water should begin dispensing from the coffee dispensing spout
- 19. Take note of the number next to "L/H'
- 20. Stop holding 'Hot Water/Milk Froth
- 21. Press 'Steam/Cappuccino' 5 times
- 22. Press and hold 'Espresso Lungo' until the display reads "HOME = Y"
- 23. Unplug the machine, wait 10 seconds, and then plug the machine back in.
- 24. As long as the 'L/H' reading while performing the tests wasn't 0, you should be able to progress past the loading screen and through initial rinsing.
